The Ministry of Education is seeking feedback from schools to help inform the design and implementation of the Network for Learning.

We are looking for a wide cross-section of New Zealand schools to take part in a technical survey, to provide a snapshot of how schools currently use their network and hardware infrastructure.

Schools taking part will have an on-site inspection of their ICT infrastructure involving an audit of relevant cabling and switching equipment, other hardware and the capacity of internal networks. The principal or ICT manager will also be interviewed about future ICT planning. Findings from individual audits will be supplied to each school (in confidence) to inform their planning.

Schools are invited to register their interest by **Friday 23rd March**. Surveys will take place from March through to August 2012.
